Job description

This project, which is a TC module (technical cooperation) of the joint FC-TC programme (financial and technical cooperation) Peace and Stability in Eastern Congo, works in close cooperation with other modules to help to stabilise the region.

The objective of this module is to tackle the root causes of displacement and, in particular, to promote employment. The project also aims to strengthen social cohesion and to boost opportunities for people to help themselves. There is a special focus on gender aspects and supporting vulnerable groups.

Location information

Bukavu lies at an altitude of over 1,000 m and has a very pleasant tropical mountain climate. Medical care is of average quality; medical services are somewhat better in Kigali, which is six hours away, and significantly better in Nairobi. At present, this is not a suitable location for families.

Bukavu is currently still a CTO location with special entitlements with regard to recuperation periods, but limitations as a location for families. This rule will be reviewed in the first half of 2019. The security situation is tense. Special precautionary measures apply to GIZ employees on the ground. GIZ's security requirements must be complied with at all times. Please also ensure that you consult the country-specific information issued by the German Federal Foreign Office.

Notes

The role requires frequent business travel in the region as well as to Kinshasa and, if necessary, to Germany.
