End of phase three of voters register Inspection

The Malawi Electoral Commission is informing the public that the third phase of voters register inspection will close to the public at 4.00PM on Sunday, December 30, 2018.

The third phase covered all centres in Mangochi, Balaka, Machinga, Zomba, Chiradzulu, Thyolo, Phalombe and Mulanje districts and Luchenza Municipality.

All registered voters in the areas covered under this phase are encouraged to verify their details at the centre where they registered before the closing time. Registered voters who have moved into the areas covered under phase three are also encouraged to process their transfers at the centre they wish to use for voting on 21st May 2019.

Phase four, which is also the final one, of voters register inspection and verification exercise will run from 5th to 9th January 2019 and will cover Chitipa, Karonga, Rumphi Nkhata Bay, Likoma, Mzuzu City and Mzimba.

Registered voters are also encouraged to check the correctness of their registration details by dialing ***2019#** on TNM and Airtel networks and follow instructions. This facility is free and one handset can be used by more than one person to verify voter registration details.

The Commission is reminding all stakeholders that it is not conducting fresh voter registration for those that failed to do so during the voter registration period.
