The Malawi Electoral Commission is informing the public that presentation of nomination papers by candidates for Presidential, Parliamentary and Local Government Elections will be from 4th to 8th February, 2019.

Candidates for Parliamentary and Local Government Elections will present their nomination papers to their respective Constituency Returning Officers (CROs).
