Printing of ballot papers for the Fresh Presidential Election

The Malawi Electoral Commission (MEC) is informing all political parties, candidates and all electoral stakeholders that it has identified a security printer for the printing of ballot papers for the Fresh Presidential Election. The company is Al Ghurair Printing and Publishing LLC. Their physical address is as follows:

The company has been identified after getting a No-Objection from the Public Procurement and Disposal of Assets Authority (PPDA). This is the same company that printed ballot papers for the 2019 Tripartite Elections.

The ballot paper printing exercise has been put on hold pending setting of polling date by Parliament. The new Commission, once in place, will also have to decide and guide on supervision and observation of the printing process by itself and political parties' representatives in view of the Covid-19 pandemic and travel restrictions.

The Commission will advise stakeholders of the period for the printing and delivery of ballot papers once all details become clear.
