The Electoral Commission wishes to disassociate itself from the polling procedure poster that is circulating on social media with a distorted message on how to choose a candidate.

The Electoral Commission is a neutral body and does not take sides to the extent of guiding the public on whom to vote for. Therefore, the Commission strongly condemns all those involved in this malpractice.

The Commission further urges all electoral stakeholders to refrain from dragging it into partisan politics by manipulating and distorting the voter information, education and communication materials it produces.

The Commission is warning everyone found engaging in this malpractice, whether originating or sharing, will be dealt with appropriately under the Section 84 (8) (d) of the Electronic Transactions and Cyber Security Act, 2016.
