Use of vehicles with private number plates to ferry polling materials

The Electoral Commission (Commission) is informing all electoral stakeholders that the machine for printing Fresh Presidential Election (FPE) customized number plates at Plant and Vehicle Hire and Engineering Services (PVHES) has broken down. Because of this breakdown, PVHES has been unable to print and affix Fresh FPE red number plates for the hired vehicles. In the interest of time, the Commission has been forced to use the vehicles with the private and Malawi Government (MG) number plates.

To resolve the situation, PVHES has subcontracted a private company to do the printing and all vehicles should be fitted with the customized number plates soon.

The Commission has advised District Commissioners to relay all information about the vehicles carrying the polling materials to all stakeholders at the council level so as to enhance transparency of the distribution process.

Stakeholders are urged to understand the situation and not obstruct the process. The Commission will be giving updates regarding the process.
